Competitive Business Environment

Support state-level leadership and funding for economic development, including business recruitment, retention & expansion and innovation programs that would establish an ongoing competitive grant program for ADO's.

• Support WEDA's supplemental request for \$5 million per fiscal year for statewide ADO funding.

Workforce & Talent

Support efforts to address immediate workforce needs and develop future pipeline through various programs, including apprenticeships. Critical areas include:

- Healthcare and nursing (e.g. LPN apprenticeship and continuation).
- Clean energy transition.
- Childcare
- Digital literacy and IT equity.

Ensure funding and timeline for Snohomish County Regional Projects is retained and/or accelerated to meet project needs.

Housing affordability and supply:

• Support legislation that improves housing affordability, increases housing supply, and expands opportunities for housing at all income levels.

Support efforts to improve public safety through additional funding and tools such as:

- Officer recruitment and retention.
- Auto theft prevention and enforcement programs.
- Address property crime for businesses.
